

Using our building to serve and bless others

You might be interested in knowing some of the ways in which our church building is used during the week. Some of these are ongoing, others happen at regular intervals throughout the year.

- On Tuesday nights, the Boy Scouts have their regular meetings. The scouts also have leadership training on Saturdays at the building frequently during the year.
- Every Tuesday night and Friday night, a men's 12-step support group (SIRA) meets in the library.
- On Wednesday and Friday mornings, the Valley Settlement Program uses our Fellowship Room for classes for Latina mothers and pre-school children, training the mothers in parenting skills and getting their children ready to go to public schools.
- Wednesday night is our own Bible study in the Fellowship Room, from 6-7:30 pm. We begin with a meal and then have a Bible study. Everyone is invited and encouraged to be a part of the meal and study time.
- On Thursday nights the Fellowship Room is used for a teaching and support group for families with members affected by mental illness.
- On Friday mornings, Youth for Christ uses the Fellowship Room for a breakfast and devotional for middle schoolers before school starts.
- Beginning soon, Celebrate Recovery will use our Fellowship Room for meetings on Saturday evenings.
- From November through March, we host Feed My Sheep's overnight program for the homeless. They stay overnight in our Fellowship Room seven nights a week during the coldest months. An average of 25-30 sleep in our building. Every Saturday morning, crews of our own members come and prepare breakfast for them while they are here.
- For several years, we have hosted Lift Up's Thanksgiving and Christmas food distributions. On two weekends in November and December they come and prepare and distribute food baskets to over 400 local families who come through our Fellowship Room to receive the baskets.
- We frequently make our building available for funerals and weddings of community members who need a large auditorium for their families to assemble for these events.

So, our building is in constant use throughout the week and throughout the year, in addition to our own Bible classes and assemblies and gatherings on Sundays and other times during the week. We are known throughout the community for our generosity with our facility and willingness to make it available for community programs and events.

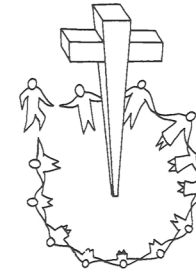
